Founders Day Celebration starts off with a parade heading eastbound on Manchester from Eatherton Road to Taylor Road where it will turn into Town Center. Parades are a great way to start off any event but it will result in the temporary closure of Manchester Road between Eatherton and Taylor/Village Hills Parkway. I would like to give all of our residents who use that route a heads up so you can best prepare if you think this may affect you.

9am – 10am Manchester Road between Taylor and Eatherton will be **open to local traffic only**. At 10 am the parade starts and the road will close to all traffic, opening west to east as the tail car passes each intersecting street. The time frame of the closure is likely to be 30 - 45 minutes, which is just enough time to really enjoy watching the parade from a lawn chair on the side on Manchester Road.
